THE EGYPTIANS WORSHIPPED THOUSANDS OF gods. None of these gods claimed to be all-powerful or exclusive. When Moses asks Pharaoh to let God's people go, Pharaoh asks, "Who is the Lord, that I should obey him?" (Ex. 5:2). The plagues are God's answer. By the time the ten disasters are over, the gods of Egypt are proven powerless, and Pharaoh makes his choices, knowing full well who God is.
